The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Krotz Springs, State of Louisiana, met in regular session, at the regular meeting place, the town hall, Krotz Springs, Louisiana at 6:30 P.M., April 14, 2026.

There were present: Craig Burghdoff, Larry Martinez, Cindy Stelly, Nyssa Godwin, Keith Ardoin

There were absent: None

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Krotz Springs were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by Mayor Carroll B. Snyder, who then stated that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen were ready for the transaction of business.

On motion of Keith Ardoin and duly seconded by Nyssa Godwin to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on March 10, 2026. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

On motion of Craig Burghdoff and duly seconded by Larry Martinez that all outstanding bills be paid. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

On motion of Cindy Stelly and duly seconded by Larry Martinez to approve the Financial Statements and Reconciliation Worksheets. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

Chief Susie Snyder said all is good in town and Logan Bates is doing well at the Academy.

James Ellis said a sewer smoke test was done and that there is something wrong between 11th Street and the Baptist church. James said when they were boring, they could have hit the sewer line. James recommended to get with LRWA to run camera in the sewer lines. A company will be boring within the next 2 weeks for fiber optic lines throughout the town. Mayor Carroll Snyder said they will be renting a portion of the Perry property for equipment and getting water from the town.

One of the lawnmowers is not working, James said he does not think the motor is locked up. Mayor Pro Tem Keith Ardoin replied that one of the lawnmowers was purchased used. James said we need a better gate to the entrance of the Perry property.

Mayor Snyder and Council agreed to demolish the Sanders house and salvage the metal roof.

On other business a ball tournament has been scheduled for May 30th and 31st at both parks. Mayor Carroll said Dr. Greene's lease is up for renewal on May 1, 2026. Council said to renew for another 2 years as is, which will be up for renewal on May 1, 2028.
