The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Krotz Springs, State of Louisiana, met in regular session, at the regular meeting place, the town hall, Krotz Springs, Louisiana at 6:30 P.M., May 10, 2022.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Krotz Springs were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by Mayor Carroll Snyder, who then stated that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen were ready for the transaction of business.

On motion of Keith Ardoin, and duly seconded by Nyssa Godwin to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on April 12, 2022. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

On motion of Craig Burghdoff, and duly seconded by Cindy Stelly that all outstanding bills be paid. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

Maintenance Supervisor Nina Snyder said the town needs to bid out the gravely and still no word on Kubota. Mayor Snyder suggested getting a different brand. Nina said Town of Melville called wanting her to take over their gas system and she said no. Dumpster will be here in June for summer clean up.

The Mayor and Council have decided to table the hiring of Recreation Directors on the next meeting.

On motion of Cindy Stelly, and duly seconded by Craig Burghdoff to adopt Resolution CWEF 2021-2022, to be used for water system improvements. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

On motion of Keith Ardoin, and duly seconded by Nyssa Godwin to adopt Resolution LGAP 2021-2022 for town hall improvements for a metal building. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

Mayor Carroll Snyder informed the Council that Genesis Contract will end May 31, 2022.

Mayor Snyder informed the Council he spoke to Jessie Bellard, Parish President, about blighted property. The parish will assist in demolition, town will see about dumpsters and the parish will furnish equipment. Town has to notify owners and get permission for demolition. The town will also be sending out letters for tall grass.
