The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Krotz Springs, State of Louisiana, met in regular session, at the regular meeting place, the town hall, Krotz Springs, Louisiana at 6:30 P.M., July 14, 2026.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Krotz Springs were duly convened as the governing authority of said town by Mayor Carroll B. Snyder, who then stated that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen were ready for the transaction of business.

On motion of Nyssa Godwin and duly seconded by Keith Ardoin to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on June 9, 2026. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

On motion of Larry Martinez and duly seconded by Cindy Stelly to approve the minutes of the special meeting held on June 26, 2026. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

On motion of Keith Ardoin and duly seconded by Nyssa Godwin that all outstanding bills be paid. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

On motion of Cindy Stelly and duly seconded by Nyssa Godwin to approve the Financial Statements and Reconciliation Worksheets. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

Chief Susie Snyder recommended that Zachery Boatright be hired as a full-time Police Officer at the rate of \$16.00 an hour with a three (3) month probationary period and attend the academy to become certified.

On motion of Larry Martinez and duly seconded by Cindy Stelly to hire Zachery Boatright as a full-time Police Officer at the rate of \$16.00 with a three (3) month probationary period. The motion was carried by roll call vote as follows:

On motion of Cindy Stelly and duly seconded by Nyssa Godwin to adopt a “Resolution a New Procurement Policy” for the LCDBG Program. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

On motion of Cindy Stelly and duly seconded by Keith Ardoin to adopt a “Resolution Affirming the Demolition and Condemnation of Properties in Connection with FY 2026 Community Development Block Grant Clearance Program”. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

Mayor Carroll Snyder reported that the restraining order for the school board was overturned on July 10, 2026. I have been in contact with Renee Aymond about moving forward for a Charter School, she has started the leg work for starting Charter School. Council and Mayor cannot be on the board because of a conflict of interest. The board will be very diverse: financial advisor, contractor, etc. I have been in contact with Mr. Rob at the School Board office, in which I will submit a packet with concerns which will be presented to Mr. Baptiste. Bus routes will still run the same route, also there will be a pickup at the school. Mayor Snyder said there will be a meeting in the Activity Room on July 16, 2026, at 7:00pm to address your concerns and University View will be there for home school program.

On motion of Cindy Stelly and duly seconded by Larry Martinez to authorize and give permission for Mayor Carroll B. Snyder to represent the town concerning school issues and moving forward with parents for a Charter School. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.

On motion of Keith Ardoin and duly seconded by Nyssa Godwin to open a new bank account (non-interest bearing), with American Bank and Trust Company for CDBG Grant Clearance/Demolition Grant. The motion was carried by roll call vote as follows:
